COMPOST/FERTILIZER

- City of Portland's Sunderland Yard Recycling Facility provides compost made from leaves collected from city streets. Contact them to request a donation: 503-823-3500.
- Livestock manure is readily available if you have a way to transport it. Visit Craigslist for listings. Please be sure to avoid manure from livestock that eat forage which has been treated with herbicide and be aware without proper composting, weed seeds and pathogens can be present.
- Contact neighboring Soil and Water Conservation Districts to access their manure exchange program lists for access to individuals who have excess livestock manure:
